

**POTOSI R-3 SUMMER SCHOOL

ENROLLMENT APPLICATION**

The Potosi R-3 School District is planning its summer education program. The following information is provided for students and parents to assist in making decisions about attending summer school:

- School will be in session from Tuesday, May 29 – Monday, June 25
- Students will attend all day – 8:00 a.m. to 2:50 p.m.
- There will be remedial and enrichment classes offered in order to best meet the needs of all students.
- Exciting learning activities will be provided.
- There will be two free book Fridays. Each TIS student will receive two free books!!
- A specific enrollment will be required in order for a class to be offered.
- A snack with milk or juice will be provided for breakfast. Lunch will be available.
- Transportation will be provided if there is enough interest at each site. There will be "pick-up" and "drop-off" sites **(There will not be door-to-door service.)** Parents will be required to get their child to the "pick-up site" each day. The bus will then transport the students to their designated school. Students will be dropped off at the designated "drop-off site" each day. Parents will be required to pick up their child on time at the "drop-off site." The following routes are being surveyed to determine interest:

ROUTE 7 (Bus #22 Horse Bus) Unity Baptist Church (Approx. ½ mile past Roy's Convenience Store on Old Hwy 8)

ROUTE 8 (Bus #14 Deer Bus) Fellowship Baptist Church

ROUTE 9 (Bus #14 Deer Bus) Lakewood Baptist Church (Approx. ¼ mile down AA off of Hwy 8 West)
