

POTOSI R-3 SUMMER SCHOOL "TROJAN ACADEMY 2019" ENROLLMENT APPLICATION

The Potosi R-3 School District is planning its summer education program. The following information is provided for students and parents to assist in making decisions about attending summer school:

- School will be in session from Monday, June 3rd – Friday, June 28th.
- Virtual Class Schedule will be from Monday, June 3rd-Friday July 12th. **(High School Only)**
- Students will attend all day – 8:00 a.m. to 2:50 p.m. with the exception of Virtual Students.
- There will be remedial and enrichment classes offered in order to best meet the needs of all students.
- High School students will have the opportunity to earn a full credit for attending summer school.
- Stimulating learning activities will be provided at all grade levels.
- A specific enrollment will be required in order for a class to be offered.
- A breakfast snack and lunch will be available.
- Transportation will be provided if there is enough interest at each site. There will be "pick-up" and "drop-off" sites **(There will not be door-to-door service.)** Parents will be required to get their child to the "pick-up site" each day. The bus will then transport the students to their designated school. Students will be dropped off at the designated "drop-off site" each day. Parents will be required to pick up their child on time at the "drop-off site." The following routes are being surveyed to determine interest:
